

PRSL End Semester/Completion Guidelines

1. All PRSL projects (i.e., work done by each group) requires a report and presentation as part of requirements for completion. All reports and presentations will need to be uploaded on the Moodle website for the course.

2. The last day of grades submission is 27th September 2019, please submit the grade by **23rd September 2019**. Please submit in the following order: student name, roll number, course number and grade and I will file it in.

3. PRSL-faculty advisers

- a) Please keep the PRSL coordinator informed about the schedule for final presentations of your students. A CPS faculty member will try to attend the talks.
- b) Students who have done good work, say grade \geq 'BB', their talk and report could be put up on the PRSL website of CPS.

4. Guidelines for grading.

* If possible, invite some of the stakeholders for the student presentation.*

Criteria for evaluation should include-

- a) Extent to which stakeholders and key issues, technical, social or otherwise, have been identified,
- b) Narrative of the problem and possible solution,
- c) Culling of design parameters,
- d) Fidelity of field work and field observations.

The following set of things (not exhaustive) to consider for grading-

- a) Clarity of student about problem statement and work involved.
- b) Ownership of the PRSL-related activities and project requirements.
- c) Effort---number of field trips, initiative towards planning etc.

Note: - an average of 4-5 days of field trips (or equivalent) are expected.(about 100

hours of work per person is expected for a 6-credits – (PS 302 and PS 624)

- d) Understanding and analysis.
- e) Documentation and presentation.
