Applicants to the MPP programme must meet **any one** of the following two **minimum eligibility criteria**. Candidates in the final year of their degree programme and awaiting results may also apply.

Any two-year master's degree or a four-year bachelor's degree (post 10+2) in arts, commerce or equivalent or an LLB[#] with a minimum of 55% marks (50% marks for SC/ST/PwD) or an equivalent letter grade*/GPA from a recognised institution or deemed to be university (as recognised by AICTE/UGC/AIU).

OR

Any two-year MSc/MS/MTech degree or a four-year BSc/BS/BTech/BArch degree or an MBBS degree (post 10+2) or equivalent with a minimum of 60% marks (55% marks for SC/ST/PwD) or an equivalent letter grade*/GPA from a recognised institution or deemed to be university (as recognised by AICTE/UGC/AIU).

*All equivalent degrees and letter grades/GPA must be certified by the respective institution(s).

[#]Five-year Integrated LLB (post 10+2) and LLB completed after undergraduate degree can be considered equivalent to a four-year bachelor's degree.

Applications are invited under the following **intake categories**. Candidates applying to **any category** will be required to have **fulfilled the minimum eligibility criteria** mentioned above. No candidate will be exempt from appearing for ADCPS' entrance exam and interview.

TA

Teaching
Assistantship

10-12 TA positions may be offered in a year. Requires any valid GATE score (including XH).

TAP/RAP

Teaching/Research
Assistantship
through Project

Positions offered based on availability of projects. Requires any valid GATE score (including XH).

FA

Fellowship
Awardee

Positions offered to candidates with fellowships or scholarships from government or semi-government agencies. Requires a valid award* letter.

*UGC-NET JRF award for MPhil has been discontinued.

SW

Sponsored
Candidate

GATE score not required for candidates with more than two years of work experience. Else, requires any valid GATE score (including XH).

SF

Self-Financed
Candidate

GATE score not required for candidates with work experience/in-service. Else, requires any valid GATE score (including XH). Applicants should have completed their undergraduate programme at least two years prior to their possible admission to the MPP programme.

Note: A **VALID GATE SCORE** is required, without exceptions, for candidates applying under **TA/TAP/RAP** categories to be considered for the same.
